❖ Proposed Budget Review

➤ Bylaws require we review a budget at the last parent meeting of the year. Budget will be approved at first parent meeting in fall of next year

- Presentation of Winter Guard budget
 - Vision is to have a Winter Guard show and support band programs
- ❖ 2016-2017 Winter Percussion Question
 - There were not enough student interest to field a program this year
 - Total expense divided by number of interested students would have required a fair share of approximately \$1500 per student. The Directors and Boosters felt this was too much burden on families and the budget
 - The Directors and Boosters are open to a Winter percussion program in the future, if there is enough parent and student interest. The Booster program would need a group of parents to step forward for coordinating this effort.
- ❖ Summer FundRaising
 - Uberthons
 - Opportunity to raise between \$12,000 - \$13,000 per school year, if fully staffed by students and parents
 - Charlotte Dinsdale shared that Uberthons enjoys working with Evergreen High School, but will need to work with competitor high schools if we are not able to fully staff events in the coming year
